DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use in feed mills, food processing plants, food service establishments, food storage and food transportation vehicles.

Kills on contact the exposed stages of fruit flies, flies, mosquitoes, cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, moths, cadelle, flour beetle, weevil. To control flying insects apply in undiluted form with a fogging applicator or vaporizer.

SURFACE TREATMENT:

To control crawling or running insects such as cockroaches, silverfish, flour beetle, etc. use at the rate of 5 litres per 100 m². Spray thoroughly all cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Store in a cool place – do not freeze. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. **DO NOT** use near fire or open flame. Avoid skin contact.

In meat packing and food processing plants, only spray when plant is not in operation. Remove all food before treatment, cover all food processing surfaces. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials to be left in the room and cover food handling equipment. Any treated surface that may contact meat food products or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use for food processing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed: Call a physician or poison control centre IMMEDIATELY. Product contains petroleum distillates, if swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If on skin: Wash skin with soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

- 1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
- 2. Follow provincial instruction for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
- 5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill and for clean up of spills.
